

where you will find the official records of the township. Minutes from all public meetings, copies of Resolutions and Ordinances adopted by the Township Committee can be found here. (Resolutions and ordinances are local laws that are adopted by the Township

Committee. All ordinances become part of the Code of the Township of Hainesport.)

The public is welcome to come into the clerk's office and review our town's records. Due to the volume of records, past records are kept in archival storage and may have to be retrieved. The Clerk's office also issues local licenses and permits such as dog licenses, street opening permits and solicitor's permits. Certain activities within the Township also require licenses.

Additionally, a rabies clinic is held annually providing free inoculations for dogs and cats. The Clerk acts as the chief registrar of voters and chief administrative officer of all

elections for the Township. Voters wishing to register to vote may do so at the Clerk's office. The Clerk's office houses the Registrar of Vital Statistics, recording all birth, death and marriages occurring within the Township. The Clerk's office is available to assist and answer any questions that you as a resident or business owner may have.

Hainesport residents can now view their present tax status via our website. Residents can also make credit card payments but only through the website. There will be a convenience fee charged by the processing company. Go to www.hainesporttownship.com or call the Tax Office for more information.

Some Things To Remember

- When you are issued a building permit, you may expect a visit from the Assessor.
- New construction and improvements will be subject to an added assessment which begins the first of the month following substantial completion, occupancy or use. The added assessment list is submitted to the County Tax Board on October 1st and the tax thereon is due in full November 1st of the tax year. If you wish to demolish an old building, a demolition permit is required. This also applies to swimming pools. Remember that any building standing as of October 1st of the pre-tax year may be taxable for the entire following year.

Enjoy & Maintain Your Property

On a normally maintained property, the following improvements may not bring an increase in assessment:

- Painting
- Landscaping
- Minor Repairs
- Decoration

The following are a few items that may affect the assessed value of your home:

- Conversion of attic, basement, garage, or porch into a living area.
- Installation of a bath or powder room, central heat or air conditioning, fireplace, porch, patio, or additions.
- Other structures, such as in-ground swimming pools.

The Finance Office accounts for, and controls all, Township revenue and expenditures.

The CFO is responsible for the safety and inventory of all Township funds. Payroll and investments are also processed through this office as well as business licenses.

Central to the duties of the Finance Officer is to assist the Township Committee with the formation of the annual operating budget and to monitor the budget as approved to insure that the fiscal plan of the Township is followed.

The Finance Office also functions as the Purchasing Department for the Township and processes over 1,000 purchase orders a year. All purchases made by Hainesport Township must go through a purchasing process including approval by the Township Committee. Additionally, all expenditures must be certified by the CFO as to the availability of funds before the purchase can be made.

The CFO is also responsible for the accounting for all escrow and trust accounts including construction and performance funds.

Our department is responsible for the enforcement of New Jersey Uniform Construction Code, which mandates the requirement of permits and inspections.

The following are some of the services our department can offer:

- We are available to answer any of your questions concerning permit requirements
- Assist you in completing applications for construction permit
- Provide a plan review to ensure code compliance
- Provide code interpretations
- Conduct inspections during the course of your project
- Issue Certificates of Occupancy or Approval after all required inspections are completed and prior to use and/or occupancy

Our department is responsible for the enforcement of Construction Permits which must be obtained prior to your project being started. Failure to do so may result in violations and fines.

The following is a list of some projects that would require permits:

- Construction of new dwelling
- Interior or exterior alterations (except those listed as "Ordinary Repairs")
- Re-roof and siding (except those listed as "Ordinary Repairs") No longer for single family homes.

- Swimming pools and fences that serve as a barrier for swimming pools
- Decks
- Demolition of any structure or interior demolition prior to any construction work
- Sheds over 200 sq. ft.
- Fuel tank removal and replacement
- Heater and water heater replacements
- Lawn irrigation systems

The following is a list of some "Ordinary Repairs" that would NOT require permits:

- Exterior/interior painting or wallpaper
- Repair or replacement of any interior finish less than 25% of the wall area in any given room, including plastering and drywall
- Repair or replacement of less than 25% of any exterior siding
- Repair or replacement of kitchen cabinets (excluding additional electrical and plumbing work will require permit and inspections)
- Repair of any exterior porch which does not involve replacement of structural members
- Construction or replacement of sheds up to 200 sq. ft. and 10ft. in height zoning approval is required.

The Zoning Officer is the first official with whom the typical property owner meets during the process of making an application for altering his/her property. It is the Zoning Officer who should receive the application so a zoning permit can be issued. The Officer must inspect the property within the municipality for violations. If a violation does exist, the property owner would be given ample time to improve or correct the situation.

The Code Enforcement officer will enforce any Ordinance Provisions of the Code of Hainesport Township so long as they do not interfere with the jurisdiction of any officer. This includes Hainesport's Property Maintenance Code.



Hainesport Township Environmental Commission

The Environmental Commission, created in 1998, consists of five members appointed by the Mayor. One member is also a member of the Joint Planning/Zoning Board. The commission is responsible for:

- Conducting research for the potential use of open land areas in the municipality

- Advertise, prepare, print and distribute charts, plans and pamphlets concerning environmental issues
- Maintain an index of all open areas publicly or privately owned in order to provide information on the proper use of such areas
- Make recommendations to the Joint Land Use Board plans and programs for inclusion in the municipal Master Plan
- Study and make recommendations regarding open space preservation, water resource management, air pollution control, solid waste management, noise control, soil and landscape protection, environmental appearance, resources and protection of flora and fauna

The commission meets on the fourth Thursday of each month except November and December (refer to calendar). All meetings begin at 7:00PM.

GREEN TEAM



Hainesport Township is on its way to becoming 'Sustainable NJ' certified. The benefits of participating in the state program include free training, grant eligibility and securing well-being for our residents. Hainesport first-ever Green Team was created in 2023 to facilitate the requirements for Sustainable NJ certification; educate, encourage participation in green initiatives; ensure collaboration and coordination of best practices within the township and neighboring communities.

The Green Team consists of seven members who are appointed by the Township Committee: two Environmental Commission members, one Township Committee member, the Administrator and the remaining members are Hainesport residents. The Team will begin meeting in 2024 to help the township meet various actions so that it may reach Bronze, Silver and hopefully the first Gold Star status in Burlington County

Hainesport Fire Company & Emergency Squad

The Hainesport Fire Company and Emergency Squad operate from their station located on Broad Street, across from the post office. The Hainesport Fire Company responds to approximately 300 calls for service yearly and the Emergency Squad responds to approximately 800 calls for service yearly. Brush & Tree Limbs

There is a Brush Zone Schedule for brush and tree limb removal. For the list of streets in each of the tree zones, please go to the township website. During your Zone week, please pile at your property curb line, not in bags. Trees, limbs and all landscaping debris created by a contractor needs to be removed by the contractor. There is no collection in December and January. Leaves can be piled at the curb line (loose) during the months of March, April, May, October, November and December. All other months please bag using paper bags. Brush, tree limbs and leaves will not be picked up if comingled with foreign material.

Recycling

Burlington County provides recycling for municipalities within the County. The scheduled pick up for Hainesport Township is every other Tuesday. You can call the Hotline to confirm the dates at 609-267-6889. Never miss a recycle day. Download the Recycle Coach App.

Appliance Pick-up

This service is available by calling 609-267-3042. Please advise what is being picked up and where. Appliance pick-up is every Monday weather permitting. You will be asked to place the appliance on the curb line Sunday evening or Early Monday morning.

Spring & Fall Clean-up

The Township offers two clean-up days, in spring and fall. Dumpsters are placed at the Kenneth E. Street Community

Center on 100 Broad Street manned by public works employees. Public works will assist residents with unloading their vehicles. An announcement will be mailed to residents prior to the scheduled clean-up date.

Hazardous materials are not included.

Miscellaneous Items

The Township tries to accommodate resident's requests to pick-up "homeowner generated materials". Please remember the following exceptions: any item normally collected with regular weekly trash, contractor's debris or excess materials, building material, hazardous material, paint, propane bottles, tires, vehicles, and concrete or blacktop.

Snow Removal Alert

The Township will begin plowing snow and/or salting roads as dictated by the storms and weather conditions. It is important to move vehicles off the road to allow an efficient

snow removal operation. It is also a violation of Township ordinance to allow any vehicle to remain on a public street where private-off street driveway parking is available.

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
