**ORDINANCE NO. 6**

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAINESPORT,  
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, CANCELLING  
CERTAIN APPROPRIATION BALANCES HERETOFORE  
PROVIDED FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL PROJECTS**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Hainesport, County of Burlington, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

**Section 1.** The following appropriations remaining as balances in the Capital Ordinances ("Ordinances") set forth below are hereby cancelled:

**Section 2.** The remaining appropriation balances as authorized by the Ordinances shall be unaffected by this ordinance and shall remain available for the uses set forth therein.

**Section 3.** The Capital Budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and available for inspection.

**Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 5.** This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.


## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
