## BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND TEAMS

### **Joint Land Use Board**

A joint board that fulfills the responsibilities of both the planning board and zoning board. It consists of nine members with four alternates and is supported by a professional staff of an attorney, planner and engineer. Members are appointed by the Mayor (except for Class III). The Board's primary responsibilities include the development and adoption of the Master Plan, review of land use applications in accordance with state and local regulations, and recommendations of revisions to land use ordinances to the governing bodies. The Board generally meets the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of the month.

### **Recreation Commission**

Consists of three members appointed by the Mayor. The Recreation Commission shall have all the powers, duties and obligations as set forth by the Laws of 1949, Chapter 138 (N.J.S.A. 40:12-1 et al.). It plans, develops, administers, manages and controls public recreation areas, projects and facilities.

### **Environmental Commission**

Consists of five members appointed by the Mayor. One member is also a member of the Joint Land Use Board. The Environmental Commission conducts research, creates documents, maintains information, reviews applications and makes recommendations on environmental matters and actions that may affect the natural resources of the community. The board attends community events, work alongside residents, groups and organizations, and engages in community projects related to the environment. The commission generally meets monthly.

### **Green Team**

Consists of five to nine members appointed by the Township Committee. Two members are also members of the Environmental Commission, one Township Committee member and the Township Administrator. It may also include a Land Use Board member and Public Works employee. The Chair shall be appointed annually by the Township Committee. Members shall reside or are employed in Hainesport and serve a 3-year term, with the exception of the Township Committee member who shall serve 1-year terms and shall be appointed annually by the Township Committee.

The Green Team shall facilitate the requirements for Sustainable NJ certification; educate, encourage participation in green initiatives; ensure collaboration and coordination of best practices within the township and neighboring communities.
