## Friendly Reminder to all Hainesport Residents from Trash Hauler

Summertime can mean house projects and pool maintenance to many homeowners. Here are the proper procedures for disposing of the items these projects create.

## Please observe the township ordinance prohibiting placing trash at the curb before 12pm the Wednesday before pick-up.

**Construction Material** – ALL minor construction material must be properly prepared for trash pickup by the homeowner. It should be broken down into 3' - 4' lengths, and tied or bundled with twine. Please only put out a reasonable amount of debris at a time. Smaller wood debris/scraps are to be placed in trashcans for disposal.

Large sheets of wood must be cut into 4X4 sections for proper handling. They must not be placed in trashcans.

Please remember to remove all nails and screws from these items for safety, and not to exceed the 50 lb. weight limit per can (no more than 2 cans).

If your project is contracted, the contractor is responsible for removal of the trash, debris and material.

**Pool Chemicals** - Absolutely NO POOL CHEMICALS (containers, bags, etc.) are permissible for disposal, as this is an extreme HAZARDOUS MATERIAL.

Burlington County residents are able to take their empty chemical containers to the Burlington County Resource Center located 22000 Burlington-Columbus Rd. Florence, NJ 08518
