

HAINESPORT TOWNSHIP 2018 SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The school year is quickly coming to a close and that means the Summer Recreation Program will be starting before you know it. The program will run for **4 weeks** beginning on **Wednesday, July 9, 2018 and ending Thursday, August 2, 2018 from 8:30 AM to 12:00 PM**. The children will be going to Laurel Lanes on Mondays, Burlington Regal on Tuesdays, Pump it Up on one Wednesdays, Laurel Falls (mini golf, foam funzy, 10 tokens) one Wednesday, Altitude Trampoline Park two Wednesdays, stay at the school for various activities on Thursdays. There will be no program on Fridays. The program will be held Monday thru Thursday at the Hainesport School Gym, 211 Broad Street. Everyday, when your child is dropped off, he/she is to report to the gymnasium so attendance can be taken. On days that they remain at school, your child will be able to participate in arts & crafts, board games and physical activity games. **NOTE NEW START TIME 8:30AM**

Your child will be expected to behave in a proper manner while he/she attends the Summer Recreation Program. If your child cannot do this, he/she will be removed from the program. **No refunds will be granted for any reason.**

Please note the following:

1. The program will run 4 weeks.
2. Program is Monday thru Thursday. There will be no program held on Fridays.
3. Registration would be based on per week
4. There may be additional recommendations on the recommendation sheet attached.
5. An additional hold harmless will need to be signed for the Altitude Trampoline Park and Pump It Up. Without the forms the child cannot participate.

SUCH AS: TENNIS PROGRAM (ages 6 to adults), DANCE PROGRAMS (ages 2 and up), KARATE (ages 3 and up). Registration for the above programs will be the same evenings as the Summer Recreation Program. ** Mandatory registration is required **prior to the start** of the program. Register early, enrollment is limited to 150 children. **Registrations will only be accepted on the dates/times provided.** See fee schedule below.

Fee schedule – Due at Registration

Registration Fee \$30.00

Shirt Fee \$5.00 each

Weekly fee of attendance – \$25 per Week

Filling out the registration/calendar: Please check the weeks on the calendar you wish your child to attend. You will only need to pay for those weeks, registration fee, and shirt fee. Checks are made payable to *Hainesport Township*. **No changes** to child's schedule can be made after registration.

- **THERE WILL BE NO VOUCHERS OR REFUNDS FROM TRIPS YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN DID NOT ATTEND!**

Registration will be held on the below dates at the Hainesport Township Municipal Building, One Hainesport Centre. This will be the only times available to register. There will be two (2) evenings for your convenience. They are as follows:

May 1, 2018 (Tuesday) - 5:30 PM to 6:30 PM

May 9, 2018 (Wednesday) – 7 PM to 8 PM

REGISTRATIONS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED ON THE ABOVE DATES.

- Only children from Hainesport Township may attend the program. The program is designed for children who have **just completed** Kindergarten through 8th grade.
- Children are required to wear a special Recreation tee shirt for designated trips. They will receive this shirt on the first day of the program, if purchased.
- In the event a child misses the bus, the parent may take the child to the event/trip. However the **parent, not the child, must inform the teacher that the child is in attendance.** This notification prevents the chance of a child being left behind at the event/trip and there is sufficient room on the bus.
- Changes in scheduling may occur during the four (4) weeks the program runs. There will be information regarding changes posted on the door. This information **will not be handed out**, but it will be the parents' responsibility, not the child's to check on this.
- Children need to be picked up on time. If this becomes a problem your child/children may be removed from the program.
- A Discipline Policy has been adopted to help prevent behavior problems. You will receive and must sign this policy at registration.

Reminders and Suggestions for Summer Recreation

Laurel Lanes: Bowling - don't forget to wear socks

- can bring own snack
- full snack bar and vending machines
- arcade
- kids need to bowl a full game (10 frames) before they go to arcade

Fun Plex: Mini Golf and Foam Funzy - we will bring a water jug and cups

- we will be outside for an hour or more; we suggest sunscreen
- 10 tokens are part of package for arcade
- can bring own snack and extra money
- snack bar

Altitude: Indoor Trampoline Park and foam pit -lockers for a fee if needed-\$2.00

- Wind tunnel is \$2.00 (not required only if wanted)
- arcade
- limited snack bar
- can bring own snack

Regal: Movies -list provided at desk at check in

- Some movies are PG and some are G; it is up to the parent to make that decision as to age appropriate viewing
- snack bar (kids pack \$6.40)
- snacks can be brought in but not encouraged by the theater
- theater can be chilly

Theme Thursdays -we will tell the kids each week what the theme is

- may dress according to theme
- may go outside if weather permits (sunscreen)
- last Thursday they may get wet (water balloons)
- bring snack
