As of this press release, there are no known Coronavirus cases in Hainesport Township.


As we continue to receive information associated with the ongoing public health concerns from the CDC, State of NJ, Burlington County Board of Health, Burlington County Office of Emergency Management and School Districts, the Township of Hainesport has decided to take the following precautions to help reduce the risks to our staff, volunteers and residents by doing the following:

1. Municipal Offices will be closed to the general public effective March 17<sup>th</sup> until further notice. Residents and contractors can make appointments, and deliveries can be made, during the hours of 7:30am until 10:30am by appointment only. Please contact the office directly to make appointments.
2. We encourage residents and contractors to use the Drop-Box located on the side of the building for dog/mercantile licenses, tax payments, permit payments. We will email or mail receipts.
3. The Construction Office and Fire Official will conduct inspections under certain specific circumstances. The Construction Official will conduct Life Hazard/Emergency inspections, NEW residential and commercial inspections and outside inspections. Please contact the construction office for more information. (609) 267-2730 x109
4. The Street Center and Municipal Park Restrooms are closed until further notice.
5. All recreation activities are cancelled until Monday, April 6
6. The Joint Land Use Board meeting scheduled for April 1 is cancelled.
7. As of today, the Township Committee Meeting scheduled for April 7 is still scheduled but the committee meeting room may be closed to the public, or at least, extremely limited for capacity purpose. Either way, we will have a live-feed of the meeting and a phone available for call-in questions. We will encourage residents to email or call any questions ahead of the meeting the administrator. More information will be made available as we get closer to this date.


