## RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAINESPORT ESTABLISHING THE 2018 TEMPORARY BUDGET

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the township of Hainesport, County of Burlington that for the year 2018 the following shall be the temporary budget plan of the Township of Hainesport.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19 provides that where any contract, commitment or payments are to be made prior to the final adoption of the budget, temporary appropriations should be made for the purpose and amounts required in the manner and time therein provided; and

WHEREAS, the date of this resolution is within the first thirty days of January 2018; and

WHEREAS, the total appropriation in the 2017 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for debt service, capital improvement and public assistance is the sum of \$3,267,010; and

WHEREAS, 26.25% of the total appropriations in the 2017 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for debt service, capital improvement and public assistance is the sum of \$857,590.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following temporary appropriations be made and that a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Chief Financial Officer (See Attached)

## GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON ALCOHOLISM AND DRUG ABUSE FISCAL GRANT - CYCLE JULY 2014-JUNE 2019

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Hainesport, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey recognizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages; and therefore has an established Municipal Alliance Committee: and.

WHEREAS, The Hainesport Township Committee further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent such abuses in our community; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Hainesport Township Committee has applied for funding to the Governor's council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the county of Burlington; and,

WHEREAS, the Hainesport Township Committee recognizes the following:

The Hainesport Township Committee authorized submission of a strategic plan for the RCASA Municipal Alliance grant for fiscal year 2019 in the amount of:

DEDR \$43,000 Cash Match \$10,750 In-Kind \$32,250

The Hainesport Township Committee acknowledged the terms and conditions for administering the RCASA Municipal Alliance grant, including the administrative compliance and audit requirements; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of Hainesport, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the FY2019 grant agreement and authorizes the payment of the minimum Cash Match requirement of \$2,200.

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ELECTRONIC RECYCLERS INTERNATIONAL, INC. FOR E-WASTE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING

WHEREAS, the Township of Hainesport desires to contract with Electronic Recyclers International, Inc. (ERI) for collection and recycling of E-waste; and

WHEREAS, E-Waste includes electronic products such as computers, portable computers, computer monitors, televisions, printers and fax machines at the end of their useful life; and

WHEREAS, toxic substances are in E-Waste and when in large quantities, which can occur in landfills, is harmful to the environment; and

WHEREAS, Hainesport Township is desirous of properly managing its collected E-Waste, reducing pollution, reusing materials found in E-Waste and being good stewards of the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the agreement for the collection and recycling of E-Waste contained herein is as follows:

- 1. This agreement is effective January 2, 2018 until December 31, 2018.
- Electronic Recyclers International, Inc. shall provide E-Waste services for Hainesport Township with the following fee: \$0.00 per pickup for 2018.
- 3. Hainesport Township will be provided with itemized billing of all costs with payment due within 30 days of the date of billing.

## A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT

WHEREAS, P.L. 2009, c. 166, codified as N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2 et seq., supplementing and amending Chapter 11 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes allows local contracting units in New Jersey to create the position of Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hainesport created the position of Purchasing Agent;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee that Kathleen Hoffman be appointed to the position of Purchasing Agent for the Township of Hainesport; and

#### BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED as follows:

- 1) The Purchasing Agent shall be appointed by the Township Committee; and,
- The Purchasing Agent shall possess a valid Qualified Purchasing Agent certificate, as issued by the New Jersey Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs; and
- 3) The Purchasing Agent shall have the authority, responsibility and accountability for the purchasing activity for the Township of Hainesport, to prepare public advertising for bids and to receive bids and requests for proposals for the provision or performance of goods, services and construction contracts on behalf of the Township of Hainesport, and to award contracts permitted through New Jersey statutes and in accordance with the regulations, forms and procedures promulgated by state regulatory agencies in the name of the Township of Hainesport and conduct any activities as may be necessary or appropriate to the purchasing function of the Township of Hainesport; and,
- 4) The Purchasing Agent will be paid a fee not to exceed \$225.00 for each time the Township is required to utilize the services of the Purchasing Agent.
